Ministerial Responsibility and Accountability

The Attorney General has ministerial responsibility for TSol. She is responsible to Parliament for ensuring that TSol delivers the legal services that we are set up and funded to provide. Our Corporate Strategy, Business Plans, budget and our business targets are agreed by the Attorney General. The Head of the Department and Accounting Officer is Paul Jenkins, Her Majesty's Procurator General and Treasury Solicitor. The Department has been designated an Executive Agency.

Chief Executive Responsibility

Paul Jenkins is the TSol Chief Executive and is responsible for the management of the Agency and accountable to the Attorney General for its management. He is also Accounting Officer - this means that he is directly accountable to Parliament's Public Accounts Committee, as well as to the Treasury, for our financial performance
